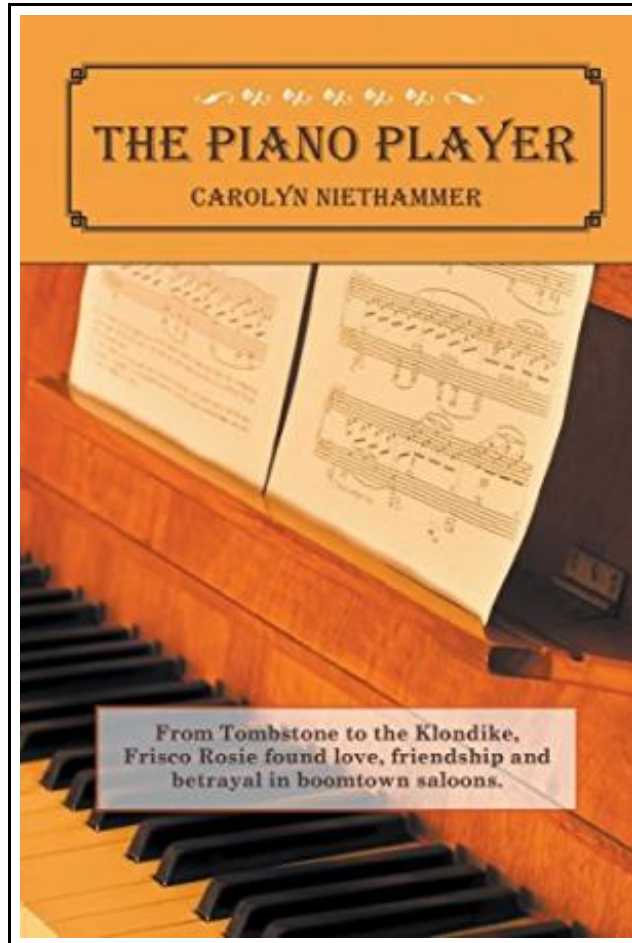

They postpone romance with the men who love them, until for one, it becomes too late. --- The author delves into the motives, mistakes and loves of her main character with unstinting candor and beautiful use of language, especially in her descriptive passages of the settings in Arizona and the Yukon. Using Frisco Rosie's journal entries to tell her story, the author allows the reader to experience the confusion, determination and conflicts inherent in the character's choices. From naive young woman to seasoned trooper, Rosie evolves in self-understanding and acceptance.
