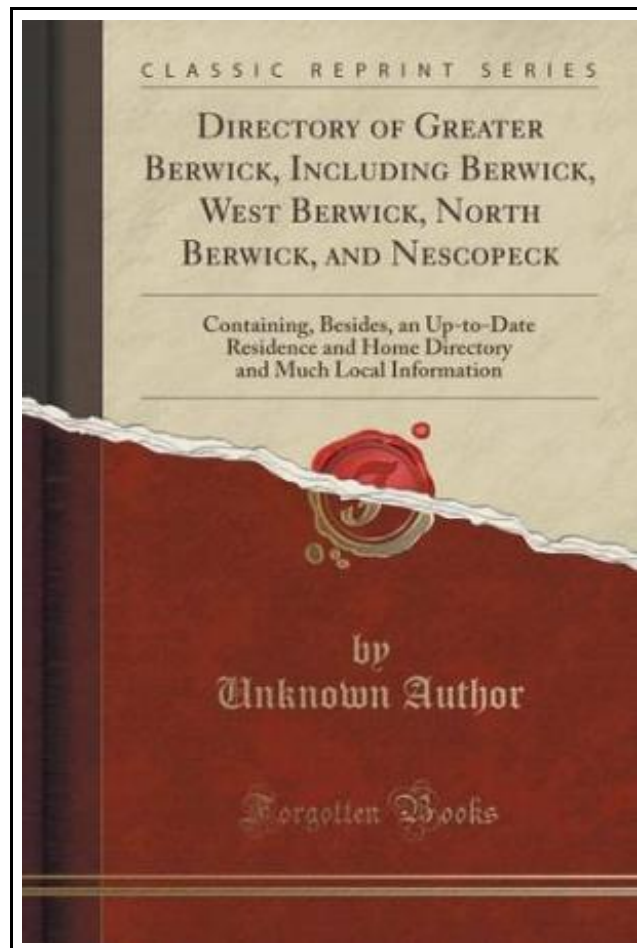

Hertz and Raseley in 1901, and republished by Special permission. In selecting material for the history of Berwick, Messrs. Hertz and Raseley reviewed all procurable histories and old letters and documents. From this data and the statements of old residents they have endeavored to make a true account of the birth and growth of our town. In 1772, Evan Owen came from Philadelphia by way of the Susquehanna river in a Durham boat, and located on a clearing at the mouth of Fishing Creek. The settlement was made up principally of Quakers, among them being Benjamin Doan, whose family name is quite familiar to our older citizens. In 1780 Owen removed thirteen or fourteen miles farther up the river (where Berwick is now situated). Here he and others among whom were the Doans, seemed to content themselves with farming and between times keeping a sharp outlook for Indians which at that time were playing havoc up the valley. The earliest settlers were from Philadelphia. During the first year or two they pulled tree tops together and covered them with bark, living in these temporary abodes until they were able to build more permanent homes of logs, etc. The farming land being of good quality, quite a number soon settled here and this no doubt prompted Evan Owen to found a town, which he did in 1786. The location was a wise one; with natural drainage, because of its location at an altitude of 100...
